Tom Kenrick is a stone sculptor based in Castle Cary. After qualifying with an HND in Stone carving and Masonry from Weymouth College in 2002, he attended Loughborough University and gained a BA (Hons) in Fine Art Sculpture.

After completing 5 years of higher education, Tom worked as an artist's assistant for public art sculptor Graeme Mitchison. In 2007 he moved from North Nottinghamshire to Somerset to set up his own Workshop.

In the past few years Tom has won several large art commissions including work for Astra Zenica and New Look. Tom is currently working on a public art project for Sheffield City Council.

Tom is also an historic building conservator. He has worked on many stone buildings, such as the Roman Baths and Westminster Abbey. Tom is passionate about stone carving. His work is commonly themed around natural forms and organic structures-which he exhibits in local galleries.

Course description

The purpose of the course is to introduce participants to the tools and techniques of stone carving and to explore the design and development of a carving. The course is tailored to suit all levels of ability and experience. Tools are available for use during the course. * The price of the stone is not included, but may be purchased from the Studio at cost.
